- I certify that I have applied to the Department of Veterans Affairs for my Certificate of Eligibility and will submit this certificate to the Purdue University Veterans Success Center Certifying Official prior to the first day of classes. Failure to submit this confirmation could result in my removal from the Yellow Ribbon Program participation list.
- I acknowledge that the Yellow Ribbon Program Remission of Fees is on a first come, first served basis determined by the date this completed application is received by the Veteran Certifying Officials.
- I understand that Purdue University is not required to continue to provide the Yellow Ribbon Program Remission of Fees if I am not in good academic standing.
